



BIG HORN, CUSTER, ROSEBUD, AND TREASURE COUNTY BRINGING COMMUNITIES TOGETHER

MONTANA'S 20-YEAR-OLD CLEAN INDOOR AIR ACT JUST GOT AN UPGRADE.

THE MONTANA LEGISLATURE, EARLIER THIS YEAR, PASSED A BILL THAT ADDS E-CIGARETTES (VAPE) TO OUR LONG-STANDING SMOKEFREE LAW. IT'S NOW ILLEGAL TO VAPE IN PUBLIC INDOOR SPACES, INCLUDING ALL PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT, BARS, CASINOS, AND RESTAURANTS.

THIS LAW PROTECTS PEOPLE FROM SECOND-HAND EXPOSURE TO E-CIGARETTE AEROSOL, WHICH CAN INCLUDE CANCER-CAUSING CHEMICALS, HEAVY METALS, AND ULTRAFINE PARTICLES THAT CAN LODGE DEEP IN THE LUNGS. IT ALSO SENDS A CLEAR MESSAGE TO OUR KIDS THAT NO TYPE OF SMOKING IS HEALTHY.

THE UPDATE ALSO PROVIDES CONSISTENCY AND CLARITY. NOW, IN ADDITION TO CIGARETTES, CIGARS, AND MARIJUANA, VAPING IS ALSO PROHIBITED IN ALL INDOOR PUBLIC SPACES AND WORKPLACE. THIS CHANGE SIMPLIFIES UNDERSTANDING AND COMPLIANCE FOR BOTH THE PUBLIC AND BUSINESS OWNERS.

AS STATED IN LAW, THE INTENT OF MONTANA'S CLEAN INDOOR AIR ACT IS TO "PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELFARE BY PROHIBITING SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES AND PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT; RECOGNIZE THE RIGHT OF NONSMOKERS TO BREATHE SMOKE-FREE AIR; AND RECOGNIZE THAT THE NEED TO BREATHE SMOKE-FREE AIR HAS PRIORITY OVER THE DESIRE TO SMOKE."

OUR CLEAN INDOOR AIR ACT WORKS WELL BECAUSE BUSINESSES AND RESIDENTS UNDERSTAND THAT MOST PEOPLE WANT TO BREATHE CLEAN, HEALTHY AIR IN OUR PUBLIC INDOOR SPACES. IT'S BECOME THE NORM.

KEEPING FOOD SAFE WHEN COOKING AND EATING OUTDOORS

EVERY YEAR, HUNDREDS OF MONTANANS CONTRACT FOODBORNE ILLNESSES, WITH SUMMER BEING A PEAK TIME DUE TO WARM WEATHER PROMOTING GERM GROWTH. FOLLOWING THE FOUR STEPS TO FOOD SAFETY – CLEAN, SEPARATE, COOK, AND CHILL - CAN HELP PROTECT YOU AND YOUR LOVED ONES FROM FOOD POISONING, ESPECIALLY WHEN GRILLING, COOKING, AND EATING OUTSIDE.

CERTAIN POPULATIONS ARE AT A HIGHER RISK OF FOODBORNE ILLNESS, INCLUDING OLDER ADULTS, YOUNGER CHILDREN, PREGNANT WOMEN, AND PEOPLE WITH WEAKENED IMMUNE SYSTEMS. SPECIAL CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN WHEN PREPARING FOOD FOR THESE POPULATIONS.

HOT FOOD SHOULD BE HELD AT OR ABOVE 140°F, AND COLD FOOD SHOULD BE HELD AT OR BELOW 40°F. REMEMBER TO KEEP HOT FOOD HOT AND COLD FOOD COLD WHILE ENJOYING THE OUTDOORS THIS SUMMER.
